Monday 19 th	36th Executive Council	In this closed statutory meeting, Permanent Secretaries and Chief Technical Officers will progress the work of the CTU. The Minister of St. Vincent and the Grenadines responsible for ICT has been invited to welcome delegates during the Opening session.
Monday 19 th	Caribbean ICT Collaboration Committee (Evening)	This closed meeting of trans-disciplinary stakeholders will consider the work done and report prepared by the Committee's Working Groups.

Tuesday 20 th	21st Century Government (Afternoon)	This workshop will emphasise the steps that need to be taken by Caribbean Governments to accelerate the implementation of 21st Century Government, which is characterised as citizen-centric and using technology for the seamless delivery of services to its citizens.
